



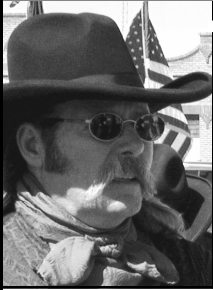

### NEW .22 CALIBER MATCH CATEGORY

The Shaketail Town Council wants your ideas. We heard one that sounds great, so we are adding a .22 class to the matches. This class is designed for shooters who want to play with us but need time to get used to the large calibers and heavy shotguns. It is limited to juniors (12 to 16) and women. Use a .22 single action pistol, a .22 lever action (or exposed-hammer pump) rifle, and a 20 gauge (or smaller) shotgun. Only Short, Long, or Long Rifle ammo, any bullet type. (NO .22 Magnum or High Velocity!) All shooters *must* be familiar with shooting and safe firearm handling. If you have questions, contact the Mayor or council.
