FROM THE MAYOR'S DESK



Howdy Folks,
Sorry about the *Tattler* last month. Things were out of my control, and we will do better from here out. The February and March standings are in-

cluded here.

I want to tell you about some changes at BLGC, as well as discuss some changes at SASS and their affect on our shooting at the Shaketail.

*The shotgunners have new gear and are building a sporting clay range. Mel Hensley is setting it up so they'll be able to do more than just one thing with the new equipment. This is an exciting event at BLGC - we haven't had growth in the other disciplines for years. Kudos to the board of directors for pushing this forward. It can only make all of the BLGC

disciplines stronger. I've pledged the Shaketails' support to help anyway we can. I'm sure anyone who hasn't shot this sport will want to give it a go.

*Shaketails now have control over match fee money, and we need bookkeeping help. Simple Excel knowledge is all it takes, since we don't have a lot of expenses. Call me, Slim or Walker and we'll explain how easy it is.

*With the Annual coming up, we also need help with other things - building props, painting buildings, food preparation, etc., so please stand up and help.

*Kansas Kid is heading up the parade committee. If you'd like to be in the parades, contact him to be on a phone list.

*SASS is making rule changes to level the playing field for everyone. One of those changes is a minimum 650fps velocity for ammunition. We will start en-

forcing the 650fps minimum beginning next match. You can still shoot ammo less than 650fps if you choose, but you won't be ranked in the match. If you have any questions about your ammo, we have access to a chronograph and can help you out there.

*Along this line, in the Spirit of the Game, we'd ask shooters to not mix light and heavy loads to beat the knockdown targets. If you're using heavy loads, use them all the way through, and if you're using light loads, use them all the way through. We think this is the Cowboy Way.

*Summer schedule starts in April, meaning we'll shoot 5 stages, so come out and throw lead down range at those small far-away targets.

Keep your powder dry.
