

Coyote Calhoun brought the Ruger Montado revolver to the floor for potential approval as a result of receiving a Firearms Approval Application. He explained the differences in this revolver and the Ruger Vaquero model. Discussion was both in favor and against the firearm. The majority in attendance were in agreement that the Montado hammer is of no concern but were not in favor of allowing the Montado front strap serrations. Coyote Calhoun will convey these desires to Ruger for action shooting requirements. A vote was taken of the TG's in attendance and the Montado hammer style was overwhelmingly approved for use for Action shooting.
