I had a good trip way down south. No snow no wind no rain just right

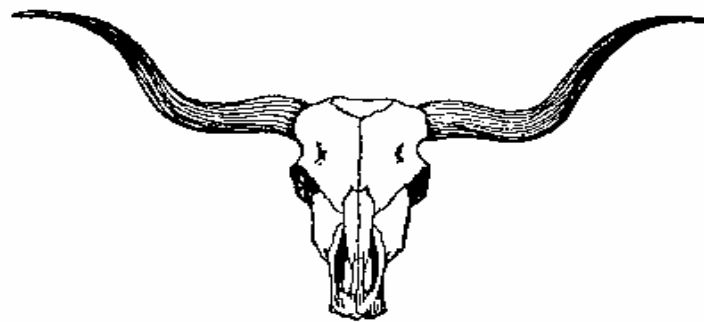
all day and all night.
